From the temperate climes of the Adelaide Hills, the warmer, harder blocks of Clare Valley, and across the more select vineyards throughout South Australia, Starve Dog Lane's boundless energy for new tastes and fresh experiences breeds curiosity, enticing like-minded wine enthusiasts to join in the adventure. At home in the backyard, or on city streets, Starve Dog Lane is constantly on the trail of a new breed of wine tastes, smells, experiences... for a new breed of wine lovers.

IRRESISTABLY APPROACHABLE

Vintage Conditions: This wine is a blend of two regional Sauvignon Blancs combining the generous fruit profile of warm climate fruit with the structure, acidity and finesse of cool climate fruit. Following the solid 2013 vintage 2014 was another wonderful year for both regions. In the warm regions fruit was picked in the idyllic cool nights of 2014 retaining good fruit flavour and acidity. Being protected from extreme fluctuations in temperature in the cool regions fruit matured ideally with good flavour and subtle structural acid even though the yields were low.

Tasting Note: Blended to create a balanced wine with the best of both warm and cool climates, this pure-bred South Aussie Sauvignon Blanc is comprehensively flavoursome. Peach and nectarine aromatic entice the nose and these flavours are reflected on the palate. With good fresh crispy acidity and fine textured granny smith finish lengthening into the finish wine rewards its consumer to the very end
