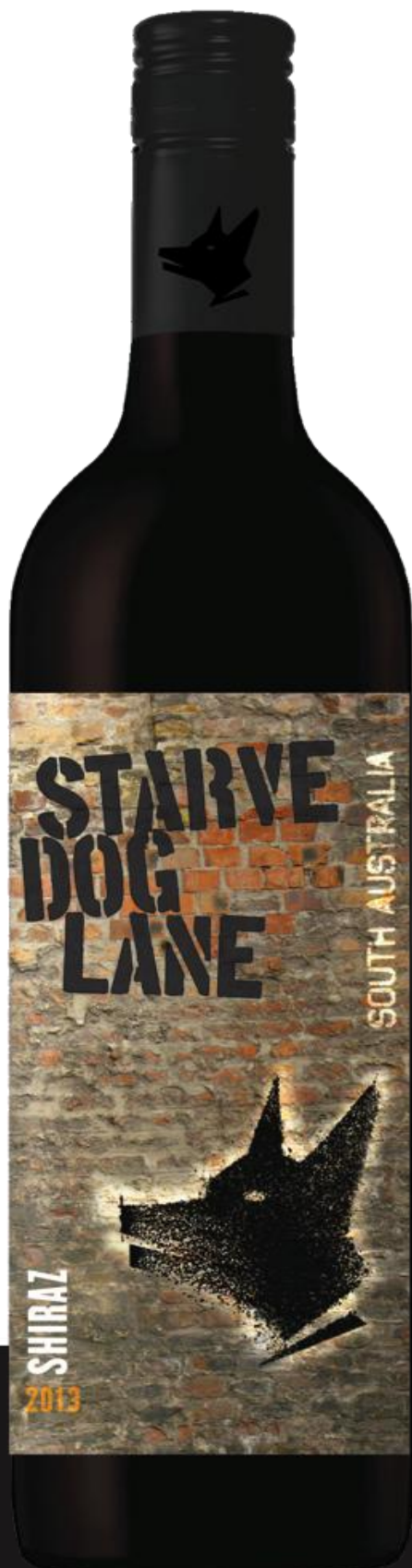

IRRESISTIBLY APPROACHABLE

Vintage Conditions: A very good year for red wines, resulting from a warm summer season which provided ideal conditions for the growing and ripening of the grapes. Picking at optimum maturity has resulted in wines which display vibrant bright colours with ripe flavour profiles, rounded flavoursome palates and soft fine tannins.

Tasting Note: Deep rouge with a lively purple hue, this wine barks with dense rich blackfruit flavours of plum and blackberries persuading palate into hints of dark chocolate, spice and oak overtures. This classically crafted Shiraz has drinkability that just won't lie down.
